5. Nuclear powers such as India and Pakistan are engaged in several cross-border wars in the last decades. China is in rivalry with the US at the regional and global levels. Nepal feels surrounded by three neighbors with nuclear weapons. In this context, what should be Nepal's position on disarmament, especially the nuclear disarmament? Write your arguments. 10
